

Feature Reference Guide

Keeping pace with recent trends in software design that employ the latest technology and enhance usability, the PC*MILER|Rail user interface was updated in Version 22 to include tools and layouts that are more user-friendly. The same functionality that our customers value is now accessible with a new look and feel. The new interface features a ribbon style design, a more organized layout for smoother navigation, and report and map windows that can be floated outside the PC*MILER|Rail application to better accommodate your workspace needs.

For users of versions previous to Version 22, this *Feature Reference Guide* is provided so you can quickly look up the new way to access features and options that are already familiar to you. The Feature Comparison Chart below compares features and options by location and includes shortcut keys. The Alphabetical List of Options beginning on page 11 is an alphabetical list of Version 21 options and where to find them in Version 22 and higher.
